October 4th 2024: Information Session 11:40. Dietz-Sullivan (Hovt 101) November 1st 2024: Deadline for student to submit Funding Application Form to Drinko Center. November 25th 2024: Dealine for notification of Funding Awards from the Drinko Center. December 6th: 2024: NCUR's Final Abstract Submission Deadline. Mid January 2025: NCUR Releases Decisions on Abstract Acceptances. January 31st 2025: (estimated) Deadline for Conference Registration: Coordinate with Drinko Center.

PART 1: Guidelines **Eligibility and Conditions**

The student must be enrolled as a degree-seeking student at Westminster College at the time of the conference and be in good academic standing.

Projects must be conducted under the mentorship of Westminster College faculty.

To receive NCUR funding, a completed NCUR Travel Grant Application must be submitted following the deadlines delineated above.

Award recipients are required to participate in the Undergraduate Research & Arts Celebration in the year of their grant.
